Florida summer food insecurity affects so many families when school meals pause. Key initiatives like Summer Break Spot provide meals for kids under eighteen, while organizations like Palm Beach Harvest offer mobile pantries, volunteer opportunities, and donation drives to bridge the gap.

Palm Beach Harvest will begin our culinary summer program teaching students cooking lessons on nutritious food prep and training. Meal programs aimed at rural areas, also known as food deserts, ensuring that children and seniors receive food support.

May 9th is our letter carrier day where Palm Beach Harvest will pick up food donations from three post offices. Last year PBH collected 48,000 pounds of food that nourished the local areas around Lakeside and rural areas. To volunteer please visit www.palmbeachharvest.org to sign up to help! PBH continues our MEALS OF HOPE packing events fight hunger by organizing volunteers to assemble thousands of nutritious, shelf-stable meals in just two hours, with 10% staying local and the rest distributed throughout the state. PBH is planning to pack one million meals next January MLK DAY at the WPB Convention Center. Look for more information as the date gets closer.

PBH has a motto “Donate Time or a Dime” We always welcome financial donations which are tax deductible to help fuel our 6 diesel and gas trucks, vans and vehicle that are on the road daily collecting and distributing 15,000 pounds of food daily to those who do not know where their next meal.

HURRICANE PREPARATION GUIDE FOR FAMILIES

“Be prepared. Stay safe. Protect your family.”

1. BEFORE THE STORM (PREPARATION)

- ✓ Emergency Supply Kit (3–7 Days Minimum)
- ✓ Water (1 gallon per-person per day)
- ✓ Non-perishable **food** (canned, dry goods)
- ✓ Manual can opener
- ✓ Flashlights + extra batteries
- ✓ Battery-powered or hand-crank radio
- ✓ First aid kit
- ✓ Prescription medications (7 + days)
- ✓ Hygiene items (toilet paper, wipes, sanitizer)
- ✓ Bible and devotional materials (for spiritual comfort and encouragement)
- ✓ Phone chargers + backup battery packs
- ✓ Cash (small bills)

3. IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS (Waterproof & Portable)

- ✓ IDs, passports
- ✓ Insurance policies (home, flood, auto)
- ✓ Medical records
- ✓ Bank/account information
- ✓ Emergency contacts

4. PREPARE YOUR HOME

- ✓ Install/close **hurricane shutters** or board windows
- ✓ Bring in outdoor furniture, grills, decorations
- ✓ Trim trees and remove loose branches
- ✓ Secure garbage cans and loose items
- ✓ Clear gutters and drains
- ✓ Check roof and doors

2. IF EVACUATION IS ORDERED

- ✓ Leave early – do **NOT** wait
- ✓ Follow official evacuation routes
- ✓ Take:
 - Emergency kit
 - Documents
 - Medications
 - Clothing (3–5 days)

➔ *Keep in a sealed waterproof container or zip bags.*

3. DURING THE STORM

- ✓ Stay indoors – away from windows and doors
- ✓ Fill fuel tanks (cars, generator, propane)
- ✓ Charge all devices
- ✓ Freeze water bottles (helps keep freezer cold)

4. AFTER THE STORM

- ✓ **Safety First**
- ✓ Avoid downed power lines
- ✓ Watch for flooding and standing water
- ✓ Be cautious of debris and sharp objects
- ✓ Check for gas leaks (if you smell gas – leave immediately)

FINAL REMINDER

Preparation is an act of wisdom, not fear. Take steps now so your family can face the storm with confidence and peace.



Lakeside is getting ready for the 2026 Hurricane Season beginning in June. We are getting together with our team to secure the building and other preparations, if it seems warranted and we begin to move through the storm categories:

Tropical Depression: A Tropical system with maximum sustained winds of 38 mph or less.
Lakeside Wardens will begin to monitor the possible storm announcements.

Tropical Storm: A Tropical system with sustained winds of 39-73 mph. Heavy rain and strong winds.

Tropical Storm Watch: An announcement that tropical storm conditions, including sustained winds of 39-73 mph, are possible within 48 hours.
The Lakeside Wardens will begin to contact response team members.

Tropical Storm Warning: A warning that a tropical storm conditions, including sustained winds of 39-73 mph, are imminent within 36 hours.
This Warning will trigger the response team into action, and the building and contents will begin to be secured.

Hurricane Watch: An announcement that hurricane conditions, including sustained winds of more than 74 mph, are possible within 48 hours.
Team will make final security measures.

Hurricane Warning: A warning that hurricane conditions, including sustained winds of 74 mph or higher, are imminent within 36 hours or less.
We pray that this will only be prepared and not needed this year but we do plan to be secured in the event of a storm.



LAKESIDE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OPTS FOR SECURITY

Many of you have noticed since Easter Sunday and each Sunday following, we have had a uniformed security officer present at our church building before, during and after our 10:30 worship service. This was suggested a few years back when we had a presentation by the Sheriff's Department on safety protocols that could offer us security and protection in the event of some type of threat. That is what caused the pastor to post on his car each Sunday the "Security" sign in a prominent visible place in the entrance to our building and parking area. We also assigned a person to lock all our doors so that they could not be opened from the outside and to keep only the one door open under with the camera active. The car sign and the locking of doors will continue but we now have a professional security officer keeping watch as well.

We wish this was not necessary BUT we feel that the world has changed and we must adjust to the reality around us. It has become clear to us that the environment has changed in a negative way, as the U.S. remains in a heightened threat environment (NTAS), driven by domestic terrorists, individuals motivated by foreign influence and violent grievances, particularly targeting public gatherings, faith-based institutions, and government facilities. The National Terrorism Advisory System (NTAS) issues specific bulletins for threats and the threat environment has evolved to a higher status.

Therefore, what you are seeing to date is the result of Lakeside Presbyterian Church engaging on a trial basis the "Uniform Security Agency" to provide a minimum of 4 hours of an armed Security Officer on Sundays and at times special events from the hours of 8:30am until 12:30pm on a long term basis.

Our pastor's car with the security sign was a good idea but not fully sufficient if an incident were to arise during the times of our worship. So, don't stay away from any threat but come with an added level of safety and security as you are our brothers and sisters in Christ, precious in His sight and we want to be especially careful on your behalf.

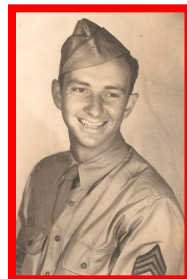
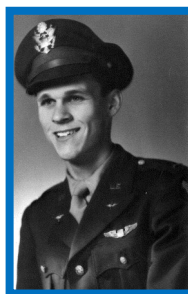

So, on this Memorial Day we will remember the men and women who gave their lives in service to our nation. Their courage secured freedoms we inherit and must protect. Martin Rinckart

This hymn was written by a minister. His family sang this hymn before dinner every night to thank God for the scraps of food they had on the table in their meager home in a desolate refugee city afflicted with famine and disease and war.

Hymn author, Martin Rinckart (1586-1649) was an accomplished musician who studied at the University of Leipzig and then spent most of his career as a musician and archdeacon in the city of Eilenburg during the Thirty Years' War. As one of the last surviving ministers in the city, Rinckart had to stretch personal resources to take care of refugees and spent most of his time performing nearly fifty funerals per day at the height of the plague. This experience during the Thirty Years' War had a profound impact on Rinckart's family and congregation but he was determined to live out that spirit of THANKSGIVING no matter the circumstances.

So, like Martin Rinckart, we will even in June celebrate as a thankful Lakeside Presbyterian family of faith a special time of "Grateful Praise".

ONE: It is Father's Day and we celebrate all the men who who have been there when we needed them: men who protected us and loved us, who taught us how to live as Christians in this world whether in the roles of fathers or as mentors, coaches, pastors. The incredibly brilliant Thomas Jefferson was the principal author of the Declaration of Independence, though he was part of a "Committee of Five" that included John Adams, Benjamin Franklin, Robert R. Livingston, and Roger Sherman. It was masterful and it was clear the United States of America was to be an independent nation.

John Kennedy remarked in 1962 at the dinner honoring Nobel Prize Winners of the Western Hemisphere, "I want to tell you how welcome you are to the White House. I think this is the most extraordinary collection of talent, of human knowledge, that has ever been gathered together at the White House, with the possible exception of when Thomas Jefferson dined alone."

When the Continental Congress, of 56 delegates, signed there was one clergyman. He was the President of the College that became Princeton University, an ordained Presbyterian named John Witherspoon who along with other signers ended the document in the final paragraph of the Declaration states: "...we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes and our sacred Honor".

We, as a Christian Church, celebrate freedom in its many forms. This was the day which began to move this new country toward the dream of the Pilgrims for religious freedom that was designed and ratified in the First Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America stating:

"Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances."

So, Lakesiders, Let's celebrate for 250 of liberty and freedom, designed for all. May God Bless America!
